PARISH PURCHASING POLICY

Our parish finances have improved quite a bit over the past year. One of the ways we have regained control over the financial picture of the parish has been to eliminate individual purchasing and reimbursements. **We are working to ensure that your monetary donations to our parish are being utilized responsibly.** It has been a while since we shared our parish wide policy, so here is a reminder to all. As not everyone reads the bulletin, we encourage everyone to share this via word of mouth as well.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

- All purchasing **MUST** be done through the office. If you are in need of anything for your ministry, please submit a request through the office in advance so that the purchase may be made by us with our tax exempt number and at the lowest possible price.

- Any ordering on behalf of the parish, which will be paid for with parish finances, **MUST** be approved by the pastor and cleared through the business office prior to ordering. All orders shall be placed by the office with the office as the point of contact. This applies to orders both large and small. Please note, even if an order has been placed in the past, it must be cleared by the pastor and business office to ensure budget restrictions are met.

- No one other than the pastor may approve reimbursements.

- Please also note that donations of physical goods being made to the parish are still to be received and used at the discretion of the pastor. Although well-intentioned, if a parishioner would like to donate a statue, artwork, etc. it is ultimately the decision of the pastor, not the donor, to determine if and how an item will be used and displayed. Donations are highly appreciated, but it is the pastor's duty to ensure all decisions are made in alignment with the mission and overall goals of the parish.
